## **DOs and DON'Ts**

### Do 🗸

- Wear a **helmet** at all times. This is required in Finish The Ride events.
- Ride smoothly and predictably.
- Leave **2 bike-lengths** of space between you and the rider ahead.
- Call out turns, road hazards, stopping, slowing, etc.
- Use hand signals.
- Stay attentive and keep your hands where you can access the brakes.
- Check intersections for your own safety.
- Watch for potholes and rough roads, especially going downhill.

### Don't X

- Swerve, surge, or brake suddenly.
- Draft behind the rider ahead.
- Overlap your wheel with the wheel ahead of you.
- Use aerobars or positions that compromise control.
- Wear **headphones** or play loud music.
